## The Consensus

- 1. That the idea of a Northeast Catholic Research Forum is important and urgent, hugely relevant and needs to be taken up.
- 2. The initiative of a Northeast Catholic Research Forum need to be Pan India
- 3. The Scope: While it may be too early to decide the extent of how far we could go in terms of issues and priorities we take up, we need to be flexible enough so that in future we are not limited and constrained by our mandate. Having said that, we would need to be mindful of the states and national boundaries within which we function in terms of jurisdiction and

administration and within that as active citizens playing different roles, in varying capacities and responsibilities. An all inclusive body would have to be flexible on several fronts. And with big plans like this come responsibility, accountability and sustainability of funds and resources.

Scope of possible activities:

- 1. Socio-cultural and economic activities
- 2. Spiritual aspects
- 3. Documentation of the outstanding work of the Catholic Church and communicating Dissemination (Communication) to the world at large.
- 4. Fill in the gap between laity and clergy/hierarchy, generally speaking as well in places like boardings and hostels where there is lack of understanding on the part of hostel/boarding incharge.
- 5. Action Research Be Organic Creators to reclaim and occupy the space now occupied by Western Colonialist concepts influencing our thoughts and writings
- Neoliberalisation increasing migration to NE and Subaltern (marginalised social groups) perspectives.
- 6. by creating awareness and knowledge production through newsletters, workshops, seminars, journal publications, etc. and disseminating the same.
- 7. Building linkages and collaborative initiatives with existing Church Research bodies like Indian Social Institute (ISI) and those in the Northeast.
- 8. Resource Mobilisation to be discussed in the near future
- 9. Structure of the Northeast Research Forum to be discussed in due course over the weeks.
- 10. Frequency of Virtual Meetings would be once every fortnight.

Members will share their suggestions to Convenors Dr. Michael Lunminthang and Mr. James Pochury who will consolidate and share with all concerned.
